

**LOW VALUE STATEMENT OF ORIGIN FOR NAFTA**

Where total goods are valued at less than \$1600.00 Canadian dollars, the formal Certificate of Origin is not required. Instead, the exporter or producer may provide a statement in the form outlined below. In order to be valid, the wording of this statement must be identical to that shown below.

This Low Value Statement may be handwritten, stamped or typed on the actual invoice for which preferential NAFTA duty-rates are being claimed, or presented on a separate form such as this one. It must always be complete & signed to be valid.
